**360** residents at a time were housed safely at Thrive Center Tacoma.

**50** families were moved from homelessness, through Thrive's programs, and out into their own stable housing.

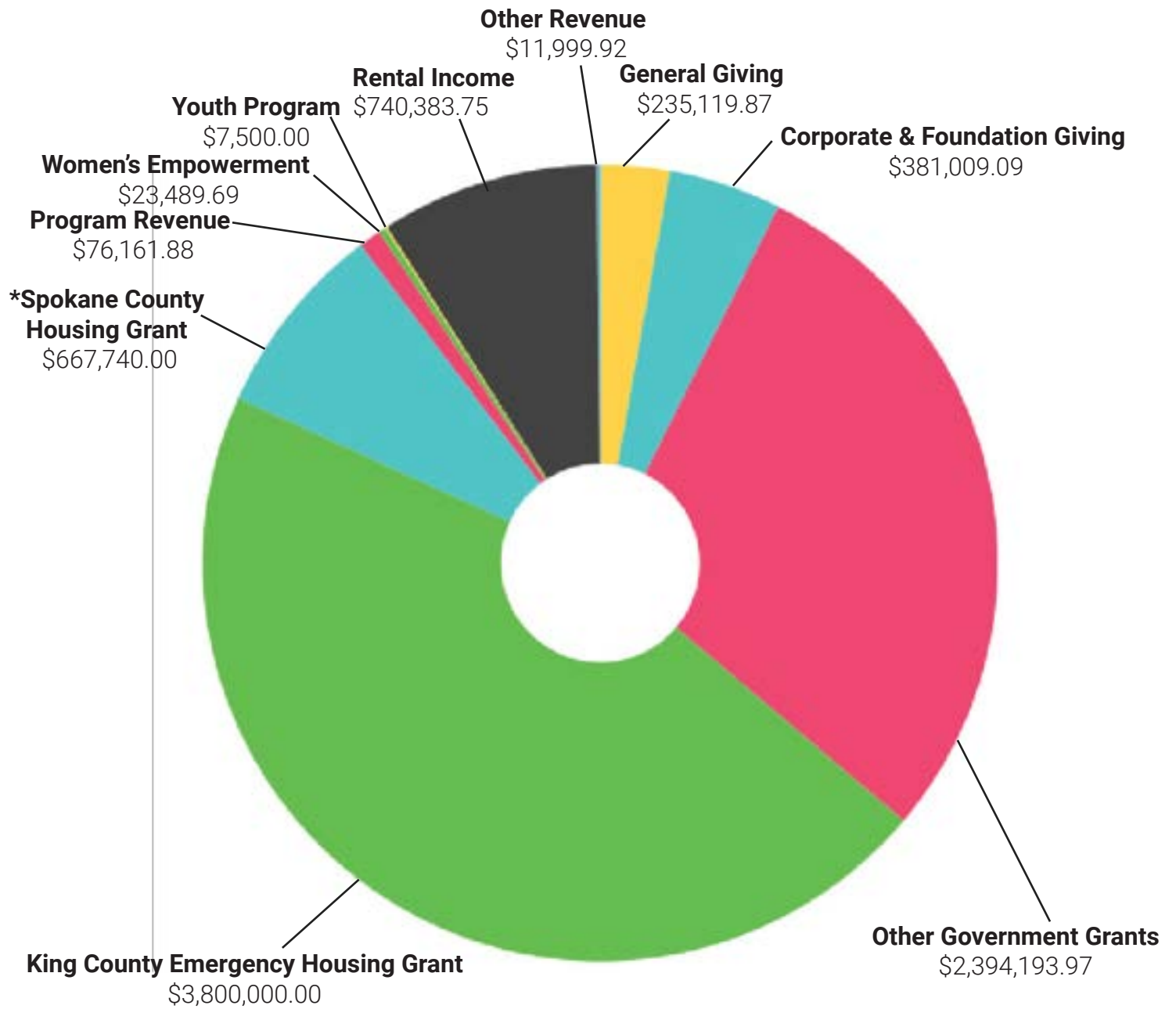

**1.64** acres of land contributed by Spokane Public Library.

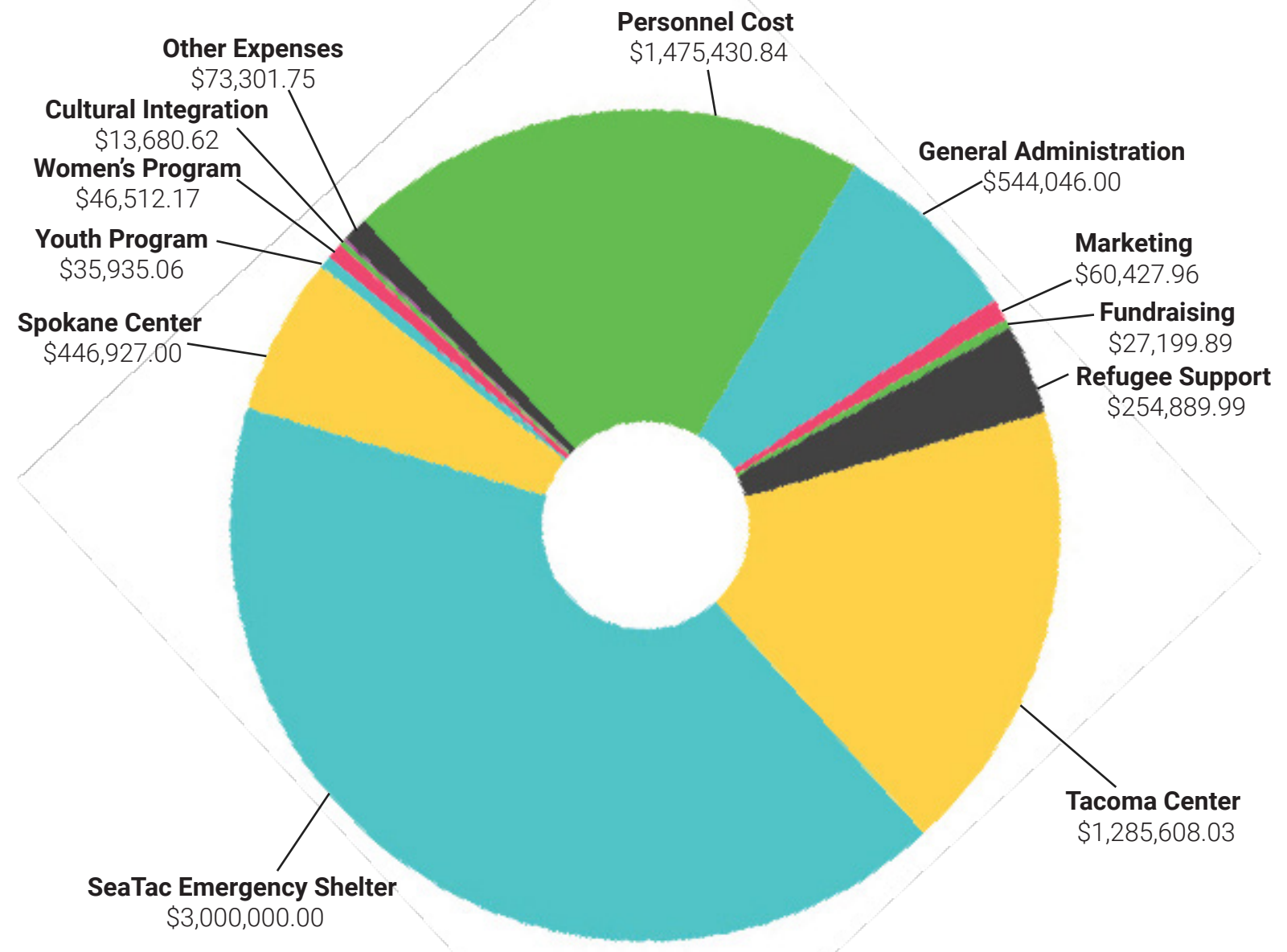
# FINANCIAL OVERVIEW
